PL79.7.

Please program both into your radio prior to the event. Net control, please try to monitor both frequencies at all times if possible.

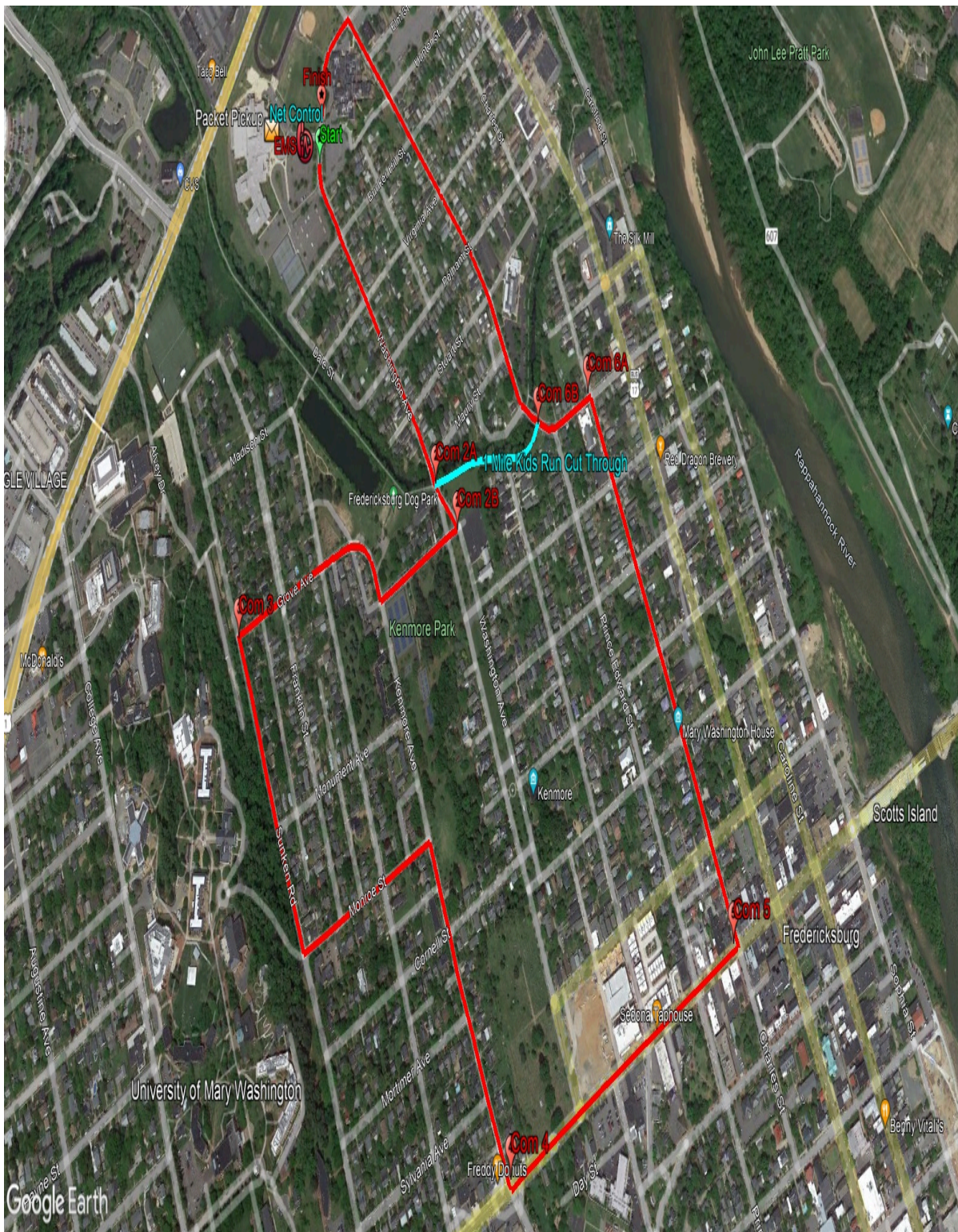
